

The primary objective of all governmental endeavors is the welfare of its people. Government of India has designed various policies and programmes aimed at ensuring growth and development of rural areas and alleviation of rural poverty.

Based on the recommendations of the Committee on Credit Related Issues

under SGSY, Ministry of Rural Development GOI formulated National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM) to provide a greater focus and momentum to poverty reduction. Among the four streams of livelihood promotion under NRLM, selfemployment is one stream that aims to promote entrepreneurship among the unemployed youth, particularly those below the poverty line. It is the ambition of MORD to ensure that 50 - 60 lakh micro enterprises are established through this stream by 2022.
